- Seminar length (30, 45, 60, 75 or 90 minutes)
- Social media handles (optional)
- Accessibility needs

TERMS OF PRESENTING

- **A/V Equipment:** The room will be equipped with a podium, podium mic, Wi-Fi, screen, LCD projector and connection to the sound system. Any additional A/V equipment will need to be arranged directly in advance by the presenter in advance with the A/V supplier on-site and will be at the expense of the presenter.
- **Presentation Content Terms:** Selling during seminars is NOT PERMITTED at the ANLS 67th AGM.
