Each committee have a Terms of Reference (TOR) document that, at a minimum, describes the purpose, scope and authority of the committee. The purpose of the committee is the most important section of this document. There should be no committee established without a clearly defined purpose.

Typically, the TOR is a written road map for the committee and contains clear and specific information on how the committee is organized, what the committee is trying to achieve, who the members are, and when they meet. A clear and understandable TOR is the first step to a successful committee!
